




Migration and economic policy


- Labour market policy: labour market flexibility encourages migration
- Social security policy: no unambiguous evidence for a "welfare magnet"

History of the Guest workers






Lessons from the Guest worker era

- High unemployment among permanently settled Guest workers from 1973 onwards
